The Delta is awarded by Cambridge English Language Assessment, part of the University of Cambridge. It is recognised by the UK government as Master's level (OCF level 7), and is the industry standard diploma in English language teaching. It is divided into 3 independent modules, all of which must be passed to achieve a full Delta qualification.
